

VC Hall sale of alcohol

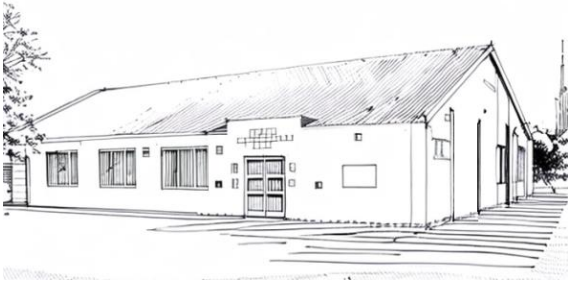
Hirer's obligations

When you hire the VC Hall and sell alcohol at your event you are responsible for ensuring that alcohol sales are within the terms of the VC Hall's premises license and comply with the Licensing Act 2003.

The terms of the license are set out on the license displayed in the notice board in the hall entrance foyer. All hirers should familiarise themselves with these terms and conditions. In summary:

When selling alcohol you must take all reasonable steps to ensure:

- **That there are no crimes or acts of disorder resulting from the consumption of alcohol**
 - Do not sell alcohol to people already intoxicated
 - Watch for any aggressive behaviour and diffuse confrontations
 - Be aware of the possibility of people drinking and driving
- **That the safety of all persons in or around the hall is paramount**
 - Do not sell alcohol to people already intoxicated
 - Ensure any spills are cleaned up
- **That the safety of children is protected**
 - It is **always** an offence to sell alcohol to anyone under 18
 - Do not allow others to buy alcohol for anyone under 18
 - If in doubt ask for proof of age (*Challenge 21*)
- **That no public nuisance is created**
 - Respect home owners in houses around the hall
 - Encourage people to come and go quietly, particularly late at night
 - When clearing up at the end of the night do not throw bottles noisily into bins



The VC Hall is licensed for the sale of alcohol on the premises only.

The football pitch is **not** the VC Hall premises and therefore drinks **must not be taken on to the grass.**





It is **always** an offence to sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 18

If in doubt always ask for proof of age
